Dear 12th Ward,

Recently, our prophet President Russell M. Nelson encouraged us to study out and understand the restoration of the gospel of Jesus Christ to the earth now 200 years ago as we prepare for general conference in April. Earlier this week, he invited us to “think deeply and often” about the question:

How do you hear Him?

It reminds me of some passages of scripture I recently read in 2 Nephi 9, which says: “And wo unto the deaf that will not hear; for they shall perish. Wo unto the blind that will not see; for they shall perish also.”

Are you seeking out your Savior Jesus Christ? Are you listening to what He’s trying to tell you? Can you hear Him? Each of us will have moments when we can answer those questions better than at other times — building a relationship is difficult and it takes a lot of effort.

I’d encourage you to spend this month getting to know your Savior and “Hear Him!” as our prophet has counseled. And if you already feel like you have a good relationship with Him, do some more listening, because there’s always something more to learn.

“Our Father loves and yearns for each one of us to choose to return to His holy presence,” President Nelson said. “He pleads with us to listen to the voice of Jesus Christ, whom the Father anointed and appointed as our Mediator, Savior, and Redeemer.”

When the spirit speaks to you, I encourage you to act on your promptings. I promise that as you do this, you’ll draw closer to Him, understand His love and mercy for you, and you’ll know that He lives and suffered for you so that you may someday live again.
